

Urology Day Unit - Refurbishment



This project was to fit out the vacant space at G-Level above the main hospital loading bay area to create a new Urology Day Unit. The space was constructed some 10 years ago and left unfinished for future use.

This unit consists of a series of clinical and treatment rooms within which a number of outpatient day treatments will be carried out. There are the usual patient waiting areas and utility rooms are provided to service the day unit. This suite now contains a lithotripter which is used to treat kidney stones using high power ultrasonics. This machine is paired with an x-ray C-arm unit for precise location of stones for treatment.

The day unit was provided with full mechanical air handling from a new AHU which was mounted on the roof by crane. This scheme also included some alterations to offices and the corridor in the centre block and an upgrade to the existing fire exit stairs to the south east of the day unit.
