- This 16 week project saw the upgrade of the 200sqm space with a new stage area featuring bi-folding doors, acoustic panelling and fixed seating for a 160 audience
- An existing audio-visual system was replaced with a video wall, new speakers and stage lighting all controlled by a specialist audio-visual control desk at the rear of the hall
- We also delivered the mechanical and electrical services, installed a new oak-engineered timber flooring, electric blinds to new windows and doors, and also new storage cupboards for instruments
