While working at Crawley Hospital, we extended our community commitment by supporting a local Scout campsite at Pease Pottage. The team volunteered their time and practical skills to help prepare the site for outdoor activities used by the Crawley District Beaver Scouts. The works focused on improving safety, accessibility and long-term environmental value for young people using the campsite.

We volunteered on-site to support the campsite ahead of Scout activities and events. What we did:

- Cleared wooded trails of overhanging branches.
- Improved safety and accessibility across outdoor areas.
- Dug holes to prepare the ground for a new orchard.
- Supported a project that would be completed and planted by the Scouts shortly afterwards.

This hands-on approach ensured the site was ready for use and that young people could safely enjoy the outdoors.
