- LST Projects successfully delivered a single-storey side extension at Guillemont Junior School where we created a dedicated SEN and sensory facility for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder
- The new space includes a bespoke sensory room, a small group room, a meeting room, and an acoustically rated classroom with modern interactive technology. A fully landscaped, enclosed sensory garden was also created, offering a calm, safe outdoor area to support diverse learning needs
- The project was carefully managed within a live school environment, with clear separation between construction and teaching areas. Deliveries were scheduled outside peak times, and temporary access ensured the school could continue operating safely throughout
- Internal remodelling, including works in the adjacent Speech Language Communication Needs classroom, was completed during the summer break to minimise disruption
- The extension was built with energy-efficient systems, including hybrid VES cooling units, and featured durable materials to ensure long-term performance. Adjustments to footpaths, additional cycle parking, and new parking bay markings improved the school's external facilities
- This project has created a modern, inclusive space that will make a meaningful difference to the students, enhancing their learning experience and supporting their individual needs in a safe, welcoming environment
