- LST Projects has delivered a new pavilion for football players and spectators at the King George V Playing Fields in Cosham, Portsmouth
- The modern facility, designed with two single-storey wings, includes changing rooms, a café, kitchen, office space, showers, and toilets
- Externally, new shrubs, trees, and artificial grass pitches have been added to complement the existing grass pitches
- Portsmouth City Council, who led the project, prioritised sustainability, targeting a BREEAM 'Very Good' rating through the installation of solar panels and an air source heat pump
- The football complex has been recognised at the SECBE Awards 2025, winning both Client of the Year and the Integration and Collaborative Working Award
- These awards highlight the exceptional teamwork between Portsmouth City Council, the Football Foundation, LST Projects, Hampshire FA, and the wider community
- The result is a high-quality, accessible football and youth hub that will benefit the city for years to come
