- LST Projects has successfully delivered the first phase of a major refurbishment at Princess Anne Hospital, enhancing facilities at one of the UK's largest neonatal units
- The project included the creation of two wards with eight cots and pull-down parent beds, a special care room with five cots, and three hotel-style parent and baby rooms

- Additional facilities include a parent relaxation area with food preparation space, a quiet room, private expressing area, and new staff accommodation for doctors and care teams
- Key infrastructure upgrades featured the installation of large air-handling units (AHUs) to ensure clean air circulation and medical spines equipped with lifesaving equipment backed by UPS batteries to ensure uninterrupted care
- This refurbishment is one of the first in healthcare to meet the requirements of the new Building Safety Regulator, successfully passing Gateway 3
