- The centrepiece of the new studio is a 30-foot curved TV screen, providing Royal Holloway, University of London (RHUL) with a cutting-edge digital environment that enhances its media and arts programmes
- The transformed space now provides an ideal setting for student workshops, lectures, and media productions. By equipping the studio with state-of-the-art technology, RHUL ensures that its students and faculty have access to a modern and immersive learning environment
