- LST was appointed by the University to deliver a new music recording facilities at its Egham campus
- This project saw the refurbishment of the 'Engineers Cottage' a building situated within the Boilerhouse complex towards the south of the campus
- The inside of the building was stripped out and reconfigured to create three recording studios and a 25ft live lounge for bands and orchestras

- Externally the façade was rejuvenated of the listed building. The brickwork was cleaned and patched, and roof tiles repaired. The Victorian chimneys were intricately restored including specialist repair of delicate mouldings
