



SOUTHAMPTON GENERAL HOSPITAL SGH - G3 WARD REFURBISHMENT

- This project involved the complete modernisation of ward areas to provide a “state of the art” facility and transform what was an older tired space
- Ward occupancy was reduced to increase personal space, adding en-suites and overhead hoists for easier patient movement
- The project included converting three 3-bed wards, one 5-person ward, and two single rooms. Hermetically sealed glazed partitions and sliding doors with motorised blinds were installed, alongside extensive underfloor drainage
- Despite a delayed start due to design updates, through team effort and extended working hours, the project was completed ahead of schedule, handed over on December 18th, surpassing the original January deadline
