



SOUTHAMPTON GENERAL HOSPITAL ONCOLOGY WARD EXPANSION

- The project involved constructing a five-storey extension (Levels B-F) above an existing single-storey building (Level A), which remained fully operational throughout the works
- Level B expanded the Ophthalmology department, introducing 40 new spaces, including clinic rooms, imaging rooms, and a spacious waiting area.
- Level C increased capacity in the Oncology department with 27 additional beds, while Level D provided a further 24 beds along with new staff facilities.
- Level E was developed as a general ward equipped with renal and dialysis facilities, and Level F housed a plant room and extended stair cores.
- Extensive drainage connections were completed in eight phases, and new wards were fully fitted out while ensuring safety for staff and patients
